<p>1 – SANTA ANITA (2:30 ET) 77 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 60K, 1M TURF</p> <p>4 SCIPIO 2-1 1 WAR TO REMEMBER 7-2 6 DETTORI 5-1 3 TARIFF 20-1</p> <p>PICK: 4 SCIPIO Maiden beat 27 foes in the 3 stakes since the debut in MSW (average of 9 per race). Bottled up, shuffled going into the turn two back. He then charged up the rail to finish within two in that BC undercard stakes. 5th, 9th and 11th two back won stakes next at GP, ZIA and OP. The one to beat today.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 TARIFF Drew the widest 10 post in the last start. He got down to the inside, saved ground and made a mild run late in the race in a good effort. Comes in with a slew of works on the training track. Modest pedigree but is a sib to a graded stakes dirt runner. He won with 2 of his last 3 on that move. This one cost 180k in 2022 but has only won about 6k. The slight drop makes sense. Was closing well in the last start despite the slow pace. Excellent turf rider up.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 TRAVAIL Last time on turf was two back when he was beaten by 5 in the same race the top choice was just in front of him. Was pressing a strong pace and tired a bit in the lane. Gets the rail and moves back to the grass after a middling effort at LRC on the dirt. Drop makes sense. That includes a strong runner-up with Father Ted here on opening day (Thu) with a similar worktab. Clockers said he showed big speed in the latest work. He's bred to win early.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 TROTSKY He is the most experienced runner in the field which is not always a great thing as a maiden. Deep closer has run past foes late in some of his starts and is expected to do so here. Gelded since his last start. Wasn't disgraced in any start on the dirt so far (5 of them). He has 4 wins and 7 in the money from those 9 starts. He is 4 for 8 at the 6.5F distance on this turf. 6 of the 8 starts were top two finishes. Will require a good ride from Hernandez from the inside post. Expect him to send and try to hold the inside.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 IRIDEO Deep closer has done some good things on the grass. He is approaching 500k in earnings. Berrios has been a good fit on him. He's won twice and hit the board 6 times in just 10 starts aboard this gelding. One of those runner-up finishes was in the '23 G1 Shoemaker Mile at 42-1. Works have been nice since that win. Really can be any kind. Looks ready in here.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 TESSUTO Connections were high enough on him to give him a shot in the G1 Santa Anita Derby. Added blinkers in last and got 3rd money in the 100k stakes. Comes back with Lasix and as a new gelding. Rispoli off to the top choice but able fill-in rider in Prat today. The pace was just too hot and those that were near it stopped. It was an odd change of style in there for this one and might be why they go back to prior rider Hernandez. Big traffic trouble 2 back. Might surprise.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 CASALU Just like the top choice, this one got too close to the quick pace in the G3 last out when Kimura moved her too soon. She got run down late but might have run the best in there considering her backside charge. Blinkers come back on in here for Baffert. Half of those wins were with Pereira in the saddle. Palma works them so slowly which is why his first timers that are live are long prices. Not facing a thing here.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 BUSY MAKING MONEY Still trying to get a grasp on how the Northern California shippers will run at Santa Anita. This is the right move. She goes from MSW up North to maiden claiming down South. High percentage rider stays aboard her. Had poor posts for 3 straight races 2,3,4 back. Checked and lost momentum 2 back. Better-than-it-looks late move to get within a length vs. better at CD in last. Always have to take account of Prat in a spot like this as he is first call for many. Flies home late.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 STAMP MY PROSPECT Get the feeling this one is more well-meant in this spot. He adds blinkers and back on Lasix. Powell is 26% with switch to Lasix with a turf router in opt clm. 6 poor runs in a row but they keep him protected. Clockers liked his works for this.
