TIFFANY LASS broke alertly to prompt the pace while saving ground under a nice hold, drew to near even terms with LIFE AT THE TOP a furlong out under strong left-handed pressure, responded willingly when his rider switched to right-handed urging to prove narrowly best in a prolonged drive. Life At The Top gained the advantage just after the start, maintained the advantage under clever handling, then gave ground grudgingly late while under extreme left-handed urging. FAMILY STYLE, well placed from the outset, worked her way forward between rivals on the second turn, angled three wide in upper stretch, then also finished with good energy to be getting to the top pair. CLASSY CATHY, well within striking distance, dropped over to the rail entering the second turn, causing LOTKA to steady, altered course well wide in mid stretch, then also closed with a burst of speed to be beaten in a blanket finish. AREWEHAVINGFUNYET, also a forward factor from the outset while four wide throughout, lacked a sufficient closing response. TURN AND DANCE made a mild late gain between horses. HIDDEN LIGHT, in hand just off the leaders, gave way in the final furlong. I'M SWEETS failed to reach prominence. DYNAMIC STAR was always outrun. Lotka was a factor for five eighths, took up sharply when Classy Cathy bore in, then gave way. TRIM COLONY was not a factor. ICE CREAM SOCIAL moved up to prompt the pace three wide entering the first turn, remained a factor for three quarters and retired.
