Trainer Mark Glatt is 2 for 5 (40%) with all 5 in the exacta (100%) with a debut 2YO sprinting on the dirt in MSW for 2YO's when off at 5-1 or less. Two of those runner-up finishes came with Prat aboard. The sire is 15% with debut 2YO's and 18% in dirt sprints. Has plenty of works. Could be serious as 475k purchase.
