<p>1 – SANTA ANITA (3:00 ET) 61 MAIDEN CLAIMING 32K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>7 CANYAHEARMEKNOCKIN 5-1 8 TOPPERS AT SEASIDE 4-1 4 GRAN SENOR DEL ORO 15-1 5 CHASIN A DOLLAR 6-1</p> <p>PICK: 7 CANYAHEARMEKNOCKIN Had no business getting as close as he did last time out at LRC. He stumbled at the start and lost ground on the turn. He found himself well behind in midstretch but was closing two to their one in the lane. Blinkers off for the first time in here and adds Lasix. Blacker has won 7 of his last 16 starts.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 GRAN SENOR DEL ORO Trainer is 6 for 38 (16%) in a maiden claimer dirt sprinting with a first time starter. The winners went off at 35-1, 11-1, 8-1, 8-1, 9-2 and 6-5. Most of those winners had a very slow 5F move (as this one does) coming into the debut. Modest breeding so a start for 32k makes sense. Will be overlooked.</p> <p>A) 7,8 B) 4,5 C) 1,2,3,9 D) 6</p>	<p>2 – SANTA ANITA (3:30 ET) 68 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 60K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>1 JUST A FANCY 8-5 3 MARULA 9-5 4 MADAME SECRETARY 7-2 2 GIGGLE GIGGLE 8-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 JUST A FANCY Stumbled at the start of the debut and ended up dead last early. She did pass a couple in a decent finish at 30-1. She closed for third in a strong MSW in last. Winner ran 2nd in a 200k stakes at LRC next (80 Beyer). Third was second in a MSW at DMR. 4th won MSW at OP next. Adds Prat for this one.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 MADAME SECRETARY Hard to believe this one is as bad as she ran. That came on the turf at 5F. She was in the 10 post and was wide. Blinkers on, Kimura off her inside. Gets Hernandez here. Cost 900k so there are expectations. Dam a speedball stakes type in 2011. Sib to '15 G1 Frizette winner, Nickname, for Mandella.</p> <p>A) 1 B) 3,4 C) 2,5 D)</p>	<p>3 – SANTA ANITA (4:00 ET) 56 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 60K, 6F TURF</p> <p>7 HAVE PATIENCE 8-1 3 THIRST FOR PASSION 2-1 4 DANZINGWITH MAXINE 4-1 6 PRACTICAL DAZZLE 5-2</p> <p>PICK: 7 HAVE PATIENCE Never got a chance to really run in the debut. She was off a bit slow, pulled and got behind runners into the lane. She didn't start running until the race was over. Didn't have a great trip in last. Doubt that was a real representation since she was laid off right after. Blinkers back on. Dettori gets up.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 DANZINGWITH MAXINE Both starts on the turf were pretty decent. She went to the dirt in the last start at LRC and really didn't run a step. She is back to the turf today and she does have a more turf like pedigree. 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<p>4 – SANTA ANITA (4:32 ET) 57 OPTIONAL CLAIMING 18K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>1 HORSE DOCTOR 7-2 10 IMPERIAL HORNET 9-2 7 HALO RANDO 3-1 4 IT AINT OVER 12-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 HORSE DOCTOR This 9YO likes to win. He has just 32 career starts (not much for a 9YO) and has won 10 times. He is 8 for 12 in the top 2 on a fast dirt track. Seems to have found the form he had prior a short break. 5th two back returned to win for 10k at PLN and again for 20k there. Needs a good ride from the rail.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 IMPERIAL HORNET Claimed in Feb for 12k and rattled off 5 straight wins for the new connections. He’s had just two subpar starts since the claim. Once in an allowance at Sacramento and one 2 back as the 2-1 favorite when he ran into traffic. Doesn’t have all that much speed to contend with early. She was a 325k purchase in April and showed talent right out of the gate in a wire to wire win on the Del Mar turf in August. Was 4-5 in the last start and ran well. Prat up. First Lasix. One to beat.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 PETITE TREAT Only one start on the turf and it produced a 13-1 win. She was right behind the top choice in the last start. She had to wait to make a move on the rail and was too late. Draws a better post for her style here. Apprentice remains and gets a weight break. Another first Lasix. Sizzling drills coming in.</p> <p>A) 1,3 B) 5,6 C) 4,8 D) 2,7</p>	<p>6 – SANTA ANITA (5:34 ET) 43 OPTIONAL CLAIMING 18K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>1 NOLDE 7-2 7 ITS THIEVERY 12-1 6 BROTHER O’BRIEND 5-1 5 UPSTART YANKEE 10-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 NOLDE This race might take a good ride to win. There is quite a bit of early speed and sets up nicely for a late runner like this one is. Couldn’t get a bigger rider change moving to Prat in here. Gets the rail and will be able to save ground until he moves on the turn. 17 of 32 in the top 2 in his career so far.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 ITS THIEVERY After getting inside posts and having to send to hold them, he was allowed to sit off the pace in the last few starts. That is going to be the right running style for this race. This is the regular rider and was aboard in the win two back at PLN. Is in good form and this is the right distance. <p>7 – SANTA ANITA (6:07 ET) 49 OPTIONAL CLAIMING 61K, 1M TURF</p> <p>5 SHEZMISBEHAVING 4-1 7 LADY MONCLAIRE 3-1 6 ASHLEYS SANDCASTLE 8-1 8 MIZ CLUBCALI 5-2</p> <p>PICK: 5 SHEZMISBEHAVING She is 2 for 12 on this turf and 3 for 12 at the same distance on the grass. She should get every chance to win with the kind of fast pace that should develop in front of her. Baze was aboard in 1 of her 3 wins when he won 6 back at 37-1 at Del Mar. 7th in last won an opt clm 40k at LRC at 7-1 next.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 ASHLEYS SANDCASTLE Just like the top choice, she will be flattered by what could be a fast and contested pace. This might be the deepest of the closers. She was right behind the top choice in the last two starts. Trainer D’Amato is off to a fast start at this meet. Only real appeal here is a fast flow for her late closing kick.</p> <p>A) 5,6,7,8 B) 1 C) 3,4 D) 2,9</p>	<p>8 – SANTA ANITA (6:40 ET) 75 OPTIONAL CLAIMING 80K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p>7 ROLL ON BIG JOE 2-1 3 MISSION BEACH 12-1 6 SLIDER 7-2 4 FOR ALL MANKIND 9-2</p> <p>PICK: 7 ROLL ON BIG JOE Has had just one poor start since October 2022 (11 starts ago). That was on the turf four back which is likely because he doesn’t want that surface. Winner 3 back returned to win the G1 BC Sprint. 3rd won an opt clm 100k at LRC beating 2 foes here. Can go early or rate slightly if the pace is too hot.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 MISSION BEACH Claimed two back for 40k and almost pulled off a 12-1 win in the first start for Steve Knapp. He was grinding away in the end to get within a length of the winner. Knapp has 10 of 15 in the money at the meet (7 in the top two). 4YO has been claimed 3 times in 5 starts. Would like a heated pace.</p> <p>A) 7 B) 3,6 C) 2,4 D) 1,5</p>	<p>9 – SANTA ANITA (7:13 ET) 36 MAIDEN CLAIMING 50K, 1M TURF</p> <p>1 MAX N’ LOU 7-2 3 UNRIVALED HERO 8-1 7 LOOKIN FOR CURLY 10-1 4 EARNED NOT GIVEN 3-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 MAX N’ LOU Trainer Mike Puype, who has had a fast start to the meet, is 7 for 10 (70%) going MSW to maiden claiming and odds of under 4-1. Took absolutely no money in either race but did outrun those odds getting beat 5 and 9 lengths. First time Lasix and apprentice gets a weight allowance. Working well.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 UNRIVALED HERO Was favored on the class drop in last and basically eased in there. Blinkers removed, adds Lasix and moves back to the turf. Nibbled in MSW in the first two starts that were also on the grass. Trainer Mark Glatt had a nice year in 2024 and is off to a good start at this meet.
