She followed that with a superb win at KD in a hand ride and a narrow miss in a 500k stakes in her third start (favored in both). Went dirt, males and dirt again in the last 3. Now back in with females and back on turf. Better than we've seen lately.

VALUE: 7 TWIRLING GOOD TIME
Fantastic win on this dirt track as a 2YO. She was bet to the 3-1 second choice and spread the field out behind her. Didn't care for the route off the layoff and tired late in there. Cut back to a sprint but might not have wanted the sloppy track. Has quite a bit of turf in the pedigree. Sire had Gear Jockey who won \$1.5M sprinting on turf.

There is some talent here but also some physical issues. He was a voided claim by the vets twice. Was 3rd in the start two back for 50k and went off favored in the most recent start. He lost his irons in there and was basically eased in. Seems at the right level here. Trainer Sharp is 15 for 59 (25%) in mid-level claiming on dirt here at CD.

VALUE: 3 WASHINGTON'S UNION
Like many in here he has some recent excuses. Came in off the layoff and ran two route races on sloppy tracks. If you discount those races, his prior form last year puts him in the discussion. He has a win and a runner-up by a neck in two starts on this dirt track when the track was fast. Trainer is overdue to break out of his year long slump.

She beat the top 3YO filly, Thorpedo Anna, and thus giving her the only loss of her 6-race career. The FG Oaks was not a true representation of her talent. She was 2-1 and did not fire. The layoff supports the fact she wasn't right in that race. Shown to like it here. Expect a major rebound.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 BAND OF GOLD It appears Ken McPeek is still trying to figure out what kind of filly he has here. He's tried her on dirt, synthetic and now turf. The Bourbonette two back was a very good stakes race at TP. The runner-up won a 200k at OP next time out. 5th won a 125k allw here Thursday at 4-1 odds. Love the worktab for this. Thought she did some heavy lifting chasing a fast pace going very long from the 10 post last time out. She was 2nd in a key race 2 back. The winner returned to take an allw at CD. 3rd and 4th came back to win MSW at DEL and IND. 400k purchase in 2022.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 FLAWLESS QUALITY Don't know how good this filly is. She made her career debut at 6.5F here on a sloppy track and got the inside post. That is not a good spot to be when breaking a step behind the field. Dam was a G1 winner going long on the grass for the same owner. He's been in 5 Grade 1 races in his last 7 starts (and other two were Grade 2's). He's pace dependent as a deep closer. Hard to know if any pace will develop here but the added distance also helps his chances. Gets Jose Ortiz for the first time and he's riding well. Seems better when the turf course is firm.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 WINNING SPIRIT Privately purchased after his last start in Germany. That was a blowout win vs. allowance company. Pretty sharp 4th two back beating 16 horses in the German Derby at 19-1. The winner ran in the Group 1 Arc d' Triomphe in France. Second in the Italian Derby. He won with all 3 of those horses. Interestingly, all 3 winners sat just behind the speed and moved in the lane. That is the kind of move that may win this. There are some very suspect runners in this race that appear to have physical issues.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 AMERICAN BLAZE Was wet and washy in the first start for Brian Lynch last time out. He then got tangled up on the first turn and he ended up with a troubled trip early on. After that, he did not show anything. All that being said, Jose Ortiz wants to take the mount. Check him in the paddock and see if he looks better today. Notice how she won easily and the runner-up was a distance clear of the rest. She drew the widest 8 post in the second start and had a 6-wide trip. Encouraged to see Jose Ortiz stay aboard. This is the third start in a form cycle so she should be at her best. Better trip here.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 MIDNIGHT TANGO There appears to be a lot of speed in this race and may set up nicely for whoever can rate just behind the early pace. This one is tactical but she has shown the ability to finish in some of her races. The maiden win trip when she rallied late would be the ideal strategy for this race. Ortiz is off to the top choice. Traveled inside in the last two with inside post draw in each. She rallied wide two back and got in the photo for the win. The winner of the last start came back and won the Grade 3 Regret here at nearly 7-1 (86 Beyer in that win). Winner two back ran 3rd in a G3 at Santa Anita.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 KIMBER SPICE 2nd dam is the excellent race mare, Life is Sweet. That one was running in So Cal at the same time as Zenyatta and gave a couple of good races. She was working very well prior to the last start. Willing to look past that one as it came off the turf.
