**PICK: 2 MISS CLASSIFIED**

Sire fee was just \$400 but she actually sold for \$70k in 2022. The pedigree leans more to route than sprint so this is the right spot. Full sibling, Butterbean, is a 3x stakes winner (including a G3) going beyond 1M on the dirt. This trainer has 3 wins and a runner-up in his last 5 starts. He is 1 for 1 coming to Canterbury (won in '22).

**VALUE: 5 MELANIA T**

This one is likely the deepest closer in the race. She's routed twice at OP and was a good second in one of them at 6-1. Many in this race might be better suited for sprints which will help this one run down some of these in the lane. Overall, it's not a strong field and it is ripe for this Ark-bred to jump up at pretty good odds.

She was nearly 8-1 on the comeback and did well vs. a similar group. The winner was a heavy favorite from Oaklawn Park with sizzling speed who went all the way on the front end. This one made an early move to her and tired slightly. Trainer Berndt near 40% with a Mn-bred in MSW at 2-1 or less who was in the money in last.

**VALUE: 1 KOOL KARMA**

Another filly for Berndt. She was in the same 40k clm debut that the top choice was in and this one was just a length behind her after a pretty bad start. She gets Lasix for the first time as she moves to the new stable for this one. Rider hitting at 23% when riding for this trainer. Sibling to the speedball Hap Hot. Check tote.

In his last 10 starts, he's been first or second 7 times. The only poor efforts came on a good turf (last out), on a muddy track (3 back) and a no-excuse to close out the 2023 season at RP. Gave Distorted Pro a tussle two back. That Robertson winner came back to win in an open allowance. He'll sit behind a fast pace today.

**VALUE: 2 LAMUTANAATY**

There appears to be a fair amount of speed here. This is going to be one of the closers who will get a serious pace advantage closing into fast fractions. He won 4 of 10 last year for 131k. The 10k - 12k claimers at OP that he exits are very strong races. Winner 2 back won next in a starter allowance for Brad Cox. Will be flying.

The winner of the local start was a major class dropper from the debut at KEE for 150k claiming. He was hammered down to favoritism at the post and won for fun. 2<sup>nd</sup> dam was a 3x stakes winner sprinting and routing. Will get a good trip from the rail.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 2 PR CALL ME MAYBE</b> Might be bypassed on the toteboard a bit due to his 18 race losing streak. But he's faced much better and was not disgraced at OP. Broke slow on a sloppy track two back but finished ok at 34-1. Might be better at a route but was second twice in MSW sprinting here last year. Shipped to KEE and was 3<sup>rd</sup> at this distance in a 118k allowance at 73-1. Toss the last two starts. Both on dirt. One on a sloppy track and other with blinkers for first time (removed today). Robertson won 38% at 2-1 or less for this ownership.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 3 VOW</b> Not a ton of turf in the pedigree and she is making her first start on the grass today. But she's in good form and in the hands of a trainer who has hit the board in all 9 starters at this meet (3 wins). Winner of last was a shipper from OP who now has won 3 straight. That race was pretty strong top to bottom and it was no disgrace to run 2<sup>nd</sup> there. Earned over 350k and is 7 for 11 on this track. He has the best early speed and have to think they will send him more than they did in the stakes. Classy Mn-bred.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 SLIM SLOW SLIDER</b> He won over 135k last year before he was purchased privately after last start at GP. Winner of the 25k Dowd Mile at Fonner but flopped in the next two. Can look past the turf start in last as that's not his surface. He will be finishing fast and should have pace to run into. Moves to Bernell Rhone who won last weekend at 36-1. Dam won over a quarter of a million dollars on the turf sprinting. The works indicate he is better than we saw first time out. He's been gelded since the debut. This rider rode the Rhone longshot 36-1 winner.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 3 MIDCAT</b> Did very little in either start but those came as a 2YO vs. high quality maidens at CD on the dirt. In addition, he gets Lasix for the first time. Rengstorf typically wins here at long odds with shippers that show absolutely zero form. Sire had the superstar turf sprint mare Lady Shipman (won 900k on the grass). This one actually is. Paynter (the sire) gets about 17% routers. Went pretty quick in the early stages in the route vs. MSW company at 54-1 last time out and rightly tired. Retains the apprentice rider carrying a light 114 lbs. Seems at the right level.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 5 LEGACYINTHEMAKING</b> He beat just one runner in the two starts so far but is now taking on a very weak Mn-bred rock bottom 7k claimer. The 6<sup>th</sup> place finisher in the last start (about a length in front of this one) returned to run 2<sup>nd</sup> as a 20-1 longshot in mdn clm 15k last weekend.
