Was nearly 18-1 in the debut at CD. He was a bit slow from the gate but finished well to get within 3 lengths. 5th won back in MSW here (I Got Game on 12/21). 6th won a MSW at AQU on Saturday by 9 lengths with an 84 Beyer. 8th best of 112 work here just 1 week ago at 4F.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 EIGHT SEVEN MAGIC Sire Good Magic won the BC Juvenile and has been a solid juvenile sire (15% debut winners with 2YO's. The only first time starter Asmussen had for this owner on this track was back in April with his son Erik aboard. He won that race at 15-1. Not easy to improve on those connections but that is what David Jacobson did. He won at TP first off the claim by 7 lengths. 3rd from there ran 3rd in MSW at TP by a length next out. Jacobson already has 3 wins here at OP.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 EL SARGENTO Blew the doors off a mdn clm 20k field at Indiana in the md win three back. 3rd won md clm 20k next and then won in a 40k claimer at IND after that. 5th won a KEE mdn clm and a CD opt clm 50k at 46-1 after that race. 3rd two back won an IND allw by 8 next at 3-1 (74 Beyer). <p>5 – OAKLAWN PARK (3:22 ET) 68 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 110K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>3 WAR MULE 9-2 12 BOTE 5-2 11 BIG COUNTRY BOY 20-1 5 SAVED 12-1</p> <p>PICK: 3 WAR MULE This is a first timer by Army Mule. He has been very strong with debut runners in his career as a sire so far. Worked in company with a filly named Gently for most of his works. She ran 2nd in a MSW here on Friday at 7-2 odds. Female family includes the 1997 G1 La Brea winner, I Ain't Bluffing.</p> <p>VALUE: 11 BIG COUNTRY BOY Showed good speed in the debut at RP but then stopped abruptly to finish 10th of 11. That race has been productive so far. The 3rd place finisher won back in MSW. The one who ran 11th dropped to 10k claiming at won by 9 in his second start. She won in her 3rd start, at same distance of 1M 1/16, on this track in 2022. Had some stretch kick in both starts. Santana stays. Expecting improvement.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 PRINCESS EM TOO Dam was a nice runner. She was 2nd in the '17 G1 Alcibiades at KEE going this distance and relished longer distances in her later career (2nd in the 1M 5/16 DG Oaks at KD). Sib was 2nd in the Zia Park Oaks at this distance last month. Trainer Phil D'Amato is 20% in 3rd career start going sprint to route.</p> <p>A) 1,2,4 B) 5,10 C) 3,7,9,11 D) 6,8</p>	<p>7 – OAKLAWN PARK (4:18 ET) 69 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 110K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>10 GOING STEADY 5-2 4 SISTER LILY 10-1 3 COASTER 12-1 1 BEE BLUFF 8-1</p> <p>PICK: 10 GOING STEADY He's done the best work so far. Was second in a MSW at the tougher Saratoga track in her second career start. Winner of that race won back in a CD G3. The show finisher was 3rd in the BC Juvenile in November. D Wayne Lukas is 28% in MSW at odds of 3-1 or less in the last 5 years. Beat her to win.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 SISTER LILY Not sure if she'll want to sprint or be at her best right at the start today. The trainer has done some good things with first timers in his career. This one might want to go longer and on turf. The 2nd dam is a sibling to Suave Dancer. Won the '91 G1 Arc d' Triomphe. <p>8 – OAKLAWN PARK (4:46 ET) 73 OPTIONAL CLAIMING 130K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>2 BIG MUCH 5-2 3 MONET'S MAGIC 2-1 5 HEAVENVILLE 4-1 6 AMOR PATRIAE 8-1</p> <p>PICK: 2 BIG MUCH Game debut win at nearly 18-1 at CD. That race has turned out to be quite strong. 2nd, 3rd, 6th all won MSW next at CD and KEE (83, 50, 74 Beyers). 2nd won a MSW here two starts later. Female family includes a few excellent G1 winners at route distances. Sporadic worktab is somewhat a concern.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 AMOR PATRIAE Added blinkers in the second start and stretched out to a route. That produced a 30-1 upset win here. Traveled wide just off a slow pace and drew off late. The track was playing slowly (all 9 other races were 6F sprints and none had half at under :46). Bred for longer distances. She won \$1.3M in the early 1980's for D Wayne Lukas. She won the 1984 Arkansas Derby against males among other graded stakes. Bet hard in both starts. Winner of debut won right back in a 100k allw and was 3rd in the G2 Golden Rod at CD.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 JENKIN Stretched out to a two-turn route for the first time in most recent start. She won that at 15-1 by 3 lengths and the 2nd place finisher was another 5 clear of the rest of the field. It was a very good effort by this filly. Mineshaft on the top of the pedigree and Quiet American on bottom. Wants route.</p> <p>A) 2,4 B) 1,6 C) 3,5 D) 7,8</p>	<p>10 – OAKLAWN PARK (5:40 ET) 45 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 110K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>7 RESTLESS RENEGADE 5-1 5 PUBLISHER 9-2 1 AMERICAN PROMISE 2-1 11 CRISIS MANAGER 12-1</p> <p>PICK: 7 RESTLESS RENEGADE Trainer and owner had the dam 5, 6 years ago. She won the G1 Alcibiades at KEE, was 2nd to Jaywalk in the G1 BC Juv Fillies later that year. She was beaten a neck in another G1 (Ashland) as a 3YO. This one closed in the debut and speed in 2nd start. Classic 2 sprints to the route move. Bullet work.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 PUBLISHER They spent a healthy sum at the sale to get this colt in 2023. He went for 600k as a son of Triple Crown winner American Pharoah. The dam was also G2 placed as a 2YO. Was third in all 3 starts for Steve Asmussen. The pace was a bit on the slow side last out.
