Footnotes

BELIEVE YOU CAN lost her footing a bit at the start, recovered quickly, pressed the pace three wide while unhurried, challenged before a half, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and proved best under pressure. BROADWAY'S ALIBI set the pace off the inside, repulsed a bid by the winner before a half, edged off a bit soon after, responded when challenged once in the stretch and held on gamely. GRACE HALL close up from the start while off the inside, moved closer on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch but lodged only a mild late bid. SUMMER APPLAUSE within striking distance inside, moved off the rail on the second turn and made a good late gain. ON FIRE BABY close up along the inside, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. HARD NOT TO LIKE bobbed a bit at the start, was reserved inside, moved to within reach along the inside on the second turn but lacked a late bid. SACRISTY dropped back early three wide, raced in the four path on the second turn, angled out for the drive but could not threaten. AMIE'S DINI bumped on the first turn when five wide, raced within reach of the lead out in the strip to the stretch and gave way. AND WHY NOT bumped at the start, was outrun early, steadied behind rivals approaching the three furlongs marker angled out four wide entering the stretch but could not menace. JEMIMA'S PEARL broke in the air, was squeezed back soon after, was outrun three wide and was no factor. COLONIAL EMPRESS close up four wide, held on well for six furlongs and faded. KARLOVY VARY bumped at the start, steadied in traffic on the first turn, steadied several times while pulling to the half mile marker then gave way. YARA had her head turned at the start, was outrun four wide and never menaced. EDEN'S MOON took up into the first turn, bumped with AMIE'S DINI soon after, recovered to be close up four wide but stopped after five furlongs.
