

ABEL TASMAN was unhurried into stride, tucked in entering the first turn, steadied off heels when a bit keen to go on, leveled into stride three deep on the backstretch, came under a ride nearing the three furlong marker, made a sweeping move six wide through the second turn and into the lane, struck the front

inside the three-sixteenths pole, kicked clear and held firm under steady left handed encouragement. DADDYS LIL DARLING settled off of the pace, was bumped and forced in by SALTY after the opening half, settled off of the inside, advanced between rivals leaving the far turn, swung seven wide progressing into the lane, straightened away and was making up ground through the final furlong. LOCKDOWN was in tight and steadied early, worked her way forward between runners, was blocked and steadied midway through the second turn, came in bumping SALTY sharply, bulled her way through into the stretch, tacked to the inside nearing the furlong marker, had the rider lose the whip shortly thereafter and continued on gamely despite the nightmarish go. VEXATIOUS settled off of the rail, angled out to be clear leaving the half mile marker to commence her run, rolled up five wide to make her presence felt passing the quarter pole, came to level terms between foes three-sixteenths out but was unable to go on with the top two. SALTY was four wide through the first turn, came in bumping DADDYS LIL DARLING leaving the five-eighths pole, continued her way to the rail, made progress into the second turn, shifted out a bit, was bumped and in tight near the five-sixteenths, was bottled up approaching the stretch, altered out to find room and churned on willingly. SAILOR'S VALENTINE contended four wide between horses to the stretch and wilted. TEQUILITA bumped with MISS SKY WARRIOR at the start, lost ground five wide while off of the pace, was under a solid ride leaving the far turn, angled out further into the stretch and had belated action. MISS SKY WARRIOR bumped with TEQUILITA at the start, recovered quick and moved up to shadow the leader four wide, dropped in with PARADISE WOODS for the backstretch run, garnered a brief lead nearing the quarter pole, was collared between horses in the upper stretch and succumbed. EVER SO CLEVER was caught in tight early, saved ground, was bumped and steadied inside the five furlong pole, worked outward into the stretch, but failed to make headway. MOPOTISM was put in tight and altered course out four wide into the first turn, remained four wide between rivals for the backstretch run, failed to kick on under pressure past the three-eighths pole and faded. PARADISE WOODS established command soon after the break, dropped toward the inside entering the backstretch, could not shake the outside pressure of MISS SKY WARRIOR, dueled with that one from the far turn, ceded the lead with a quarter to go and gave way readily through the final three-sixteenths. JORDAN'S HENNY within range inside early, angled out to give chase, remained a presence to the five-sixteenths then retreated. WICKED LICK saved ground while well back, steadied slightly in the jam up near the five-eighths pole, leveled back into stride but was never a factor. FARRELL had dead aim off the contested pace, failed to respond when put to pressure leaving the three-eighths pole, faded fast between horses, lost contact entering the stretch, was eased to the wire but walked off.
