 Upset winner of the G3 Holy Bull earlier this year. He comes in off a solid runner-up in the G3 Dwyer at 5-1 odds. The third place finisher was 2nd in an opt clm at SAR Sunday. Likely didn't care for blinkers on two and three back. Regular rider (Paco Lopez) is back up today.

VALUE: 7 AWESOME RUTA
 Two pretty good races in allowance company since he was moved to Dan Ward. He nibbled in good Ky Derby prep races in Louisiana. 5 of his last 9 starts were on turf or an off dirt track. Gets Joe Bravo here and may enjoy a good trip from a wide post. Likely underneath.

 She's turned into a deep closer. Came from near last in the 3 starts so far in 2024 but was moving well late in each of them. 3 of the runners who ran back from the Miss Preakness won right back (7 hit the board out of that race). Will get some pace to set up her late kick.

VALUE: 2 DAZZLING MOVE
 Winner of two of her last four starts. She did not fire in the two races in between (sans Lasix). Eased in last and ran evenly on turf. The 7F distance could be right in her wheelhouse. Trainer has been on the board 20 of 30 local starts. This rider was up in the win 2 back.

 She's run on a firm turf 6 times. She won 4 of those and was second in the other two. All of them were at 5F - 5.5F. Paco Lopez is two for two aboard her. She hit the rail and steadied in the last start but bravely overcame it to win. 90, 91 Beyers in '24 stand out here.

VALUE: 5 MEDALLA MATCH
 6YO mare was once a 16k claimer at Canterbury Park. She rattled off 3 straight wins at the end of 2023 and was then moved to this trainer, Cherie DeVaux. Both of her starts in 2024 were in the deep end of the pool. She wasn't disgraced in that G3, beaten just 3 lengths.

This is a real racehorse. He's only been out of the top two in two races in his last 14 starts. He is 8 for 9 in the exacta sprinting on the turf. Winner two back won for the 4th time in 5 starts when he took a 100k MTH stakes next. Rider up for 4 wins on him in 5 total starts.

VALUE: 1 DREAM SHAKE

Was third in the Grade 1 Santa Anita Derby back in '21 behind Rock Your World. Became a G2 winner at WO 4 back at 10-1. Fast closing 5th beaten a neck from the rail two back in another G2 there. Caught some traffic in the Kennedy Road in last but closed nicely for third.

Gets the turf influence from the sire (a son of Galileo) and class from the female side that produced \$2.2M earner, Sun King. Made the same move in all 3 wins. He accelerated on the turn and grinded away late. 4th from last was 2nd a neck in the G2 500k HOF at SAR next.

VALUE: 4 IN A JAM

Beat Trikari at GP going 7.5F in the start five back. He should end up in a perfect spot early. He has enough speed to gain position but has shown the ability to run fast in the stretch. Might not have wanted the softer turf in last. Been in the exacta in 4 of 6 at the distance.

Just got a miserable ride by Saez last time out. He was wide with her all the way around the track losing a lot of ground on all the turns. Massive runner-up finish in the G1 New York. Former 25k claimer turned into a legit turfer. Not a lot of speed here. Will be closer early.

VALUE: 1 INTEGRATION

Won all 3 starts on this turf and really did so with ease each time. Dominated an overmatched field as a prep for this race. No disgrace in the 3 losses as all came against Grade 1 company. Carmouche is 3 for 3 aboard this colt. Will save ground from the inside post today.

VALUE: 7 MORE THAN LOOKS

This is a real runner. He was supposed to start in the Lure last weekend but that was washed out. Won 3 of his last 4 leading into the BC Mile and then ran huge to get within 2-lengths at 16-1 in that G1. Picks up one of the top riders, Irad Ortiz. Will be moving in the lane.

VALUE: 3 ROYAL MAJESTY

Shipped in from overseas and won 2 of 3 before trying graded stakes company. Wasn't disgraced in either of the graded stakes getting beat less than two in both of them. Certainly bred to be a good one and is in the hands of top connections. Will be finishing fast today.
