She was nearly 18-1 in her debut which came at KEE in April. She made up some ground to get third but about 11 behind the top two finishers. That race produced two stakes winners (runner-up won a 250k Ky Juvenile next out at KEE and 5th won the Astoria at SAR at 14-1 later). The sire was a 5-time G2 winner having won 7 of 9 starts.

VALUE: 6 DARE TO BREEZE

The sire (Daredevil) was an excellent 2YO. He won first time out by 6-lengths with a 96 Beyer and then won the G1 Champagne with a 107 Beyer. His best offspring was the G1 Ky Oaks runner-up and Preakness winner Swiss Skydiver. Trainer is 2 for 8 (25%) with a debut 2YO here at CD sprinting on dirt with this rider (Gaffalione) aboard.

Debut in a maiden special weight at Fair Grounds wasn't too bad. He split the field beaten 9 lengths against solid 3YO's back in Feb. Routed in a key race at nearly 60-1 in the second start. 2nd, 3rd, 4th place finishers all came back to win the next start. Trainer is 5 for 15 (33%) on a drop to MSW at CD sprinting on dirt (high level claiming).

VALUE: 8 ZECA DIABO

Finally moved to the dirt on the class drop in the last at KEE. He broke slow and never got involved in the race. Of the 4 horses who have run back from that race, 2 of them won (MSW at FL and MSW at IND). The winner was second in a starter allowance here next out (77 Beyer). Has previously nibbled vs. good runners on TP synthetic.

She started her career winning her first 3 races and then was a solid second to ill-fated superstar Maple Leaf Mel. She has been a beaten favorite in 3 of her last 4 starts. First place finisher two back won at this level next start. 2nd three back won a 100k next by 10. Back on Lasix today.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 EFFORTLESSLYELGANT She has only been in a dirt sprint on a fast track 3 times in her career. She won once (last out) and was a good 4th in the other two. She's taken a ton of money nearly every time out (favored in 6 of 9 starts). Comes in off a career best effort returning from a layoff. Trainer has 3 wins at the meet and has heated up. Bet hard in the debut and ran to the action. He was 3-1 next out but weakened and wasn't seen until a start in April. 4 next out winners from that last race at KEE and 3 more ran 2nd next. Expect to see much more.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 COWBOY CACHE Excellent pedigree. 2nd dam on the female side is Grade 1 winner on turf, Fire the Groom. She won the 1991 G1 Beverly D at Arlington Park. This 310k purchase has had just two starts and both were sprinting. He passed some late in the last start from the wide 11 post at 5.5F for a solid 4th place finish. It looks like a good claim as this 5YO gelding was a sharp 3-5 winner. He's 3 for 5 on this dirt track and 5 for 12 overall on a fast dirt track. Distance may be a tad sharp for him but he should get an ideal race flow to close into.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 MARKET STREET This 275k 2022 purchase has had 13 career starts. He's had Lasix in just 2 of them producing a 7-1 win and 10-1 show finish (3 and 4 starts ago). Been on an off-track in 4 of 12 dirt starts and was on soft turf in another. Looks like a sprinter and should find this field a bit more to his liking. Consider the 3rd place finisher went to SAR and won a rich allowance by 8-lengths earning a 102 fig.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 MONSIEUR CANDY Was a nose away from winning the start two back which was his turf debut. The public wasn't convinced and let him get away at 16-1 in the next start when he ran over a full field by nearly 3-lengths with a 94 Beyer. Appears to like the turf. Broke quickly in last so expect Lanerie to send him from the inside. This colt beat better at TP which was a tough track to win on this past winter.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 HALLELUJAH HARRIS Ended his 2YO season with a dreadful effort in a tough MSW at ELP. He came back with Lasix off the long break and was 4th passing horses in the lane vs similar in last start. Goes back to Graham who rode him in the first two start.
