<p><b>1 – SANTA ANITA (3:00 ET) 56</b>  <b>MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 60K, 6F TURF</b></p> <p>7 SPANISH CARA 9-2                  2 CYPRUS MOON 9-5                  5 SKATINGTHROUGHLIFE 8-1                  1 WAY TOO SEXY 8-5</p> <p><b>PICK: 7 SPANISH CARA</b>                  She beat 26 foes in Ireland when on the board in big fields in all 3 starts. Bad post 3 back but came on well to get 5<sup>th</sup> beaten two. Blinkers had her pressing a fast pace two back. Drops back to the sprint for the first time in the US. Female line includes G1 Irish Derby winner, millionaire Desert King.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 5 SKATINGTHROUGHLIFE</b>                  Took no money in the debut with an apprentice rider. She ran evenly in a common race at 5F. Major change today to Prat and adds an extra furlong. Have to pay attention when one sells for 150k with a sire fee of just 5k. Comes into this with 5 works since that debut. Think she shows much more.</p> <p>A) 2,7 B) 1,5,6 C) 4 D) 3</p>	<p><b>2 – SANTA ANITA (3:31 ET) 79</b>  <b>OPTIONAL CLAIMING 50K, 6F DIRT</b></p> <p>5 STYLISH CAT 3-5                  3 SILVERADO STORM 6-1                  1 PANUCO 10-1                  2 ONE SMOKIN DUDE 9-5</p> <p><b>PICK: 5 STYLISH CAT</b>                  He's already beaten everyone in this field except for the 2. Picked up checks in 2 Cal-bred stakes. Was 4<sup>th</sup> in the 176k Golden State Juvenile two back but beaten just 2-lengths in there. Tends to break quickly and draw an advantageous wide post. Clearly the one to beat at pretty low odds today.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 3 SILVERADO STORM</b>                  Can make excuses for a couple of his starts. Stumbled out of the gate in the last start at 5-2 odds and lost all chance. Burned up on the lead in the Golden State Juvenile in fast fractions and tired. The win was wire to wire so look for this rider to get him out front and try to clear off. The main pace.</p> <p>A) 5 B) C) 1,2,3,4 D)</p>	<p><b>3 – SANTA ANITA (4:01 ET) 38</b>  <b>CLAIMING 25K, 6.5F TURF</b></p> <p>3 NASHOBA'S JOY 6-1                  6 FORTY NINE GOLD 4-1                  8 SMOOTH SALUTE 15-1                  7 NAISMITH 6-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 3 NASHOBA'S JOY</b>                  Deep closer hinted at ability earlier in his career but hasn't shown enough of late. Thus, the connections are dropping back in for a tag. Will be closing in from dead last cutting back in distance for this one. If Hernandez can get him into this early enough, he could be tough to hold off in the lane.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 8 SMOOTH SALUTE</b>                  Claimed for 50k exactly one year ago to the day. He rattled off 3 straight strong efforts off the claim. Toss the dirt start after that and finished well at GG for runner-up in an allw. Wide post two back at 16-1 vs. better. Toss last when not finishing after hitting the rail. Love the worktab coming in.</p> <p>A) 3,6,7,8 B) 4,5 C) 2,9 D) 1,10</p>
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<p>4 – SANTA ANITA (4:33 ET) 34 MAIDEN CLAIMING 20K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>8 IGNATOWSKI 5-2 3 CRONE ZONE 8-1 1 AUDIBLE SILENCE 6-1 5 FACTORY DRIVE 10-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 8 IGNATOWSKI</b> He's been on the board in 5 of the last 6 starts. The only miss was 5 back when he broke from the 10 post and ended up having a very wide trip. Was wide in last at LRC and that is not the place to be on that track. Facing a lot of horses who have major questions in here. He'll run past tired foes late.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 3 CRONE ZONE</b> There are obviously problems with this one as this is the 1<sup>st</sup> start in nearly 15 months. Ran ok in the debut vs. better at Del Mar. Lots of changes. Major class drop, blinkers on, has been gelded and gets Lasix. Kruljac is throwing the book at him in hopes to wake him up. Good spot to make his return.</p> <p>A) 8 B) 1,3,4,5 C) 6,7,9 D) 2</p>	<p>5 – SANTA ANITA (5:04 ET) 70 OPTIONAL CLAIMING 61K, 6F TURF</p> <p>10 SOHO 10-1 8 RASCALITY 4-1 9 ANG N ASH 5-1 2 QUEEN MAXIMA 2-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 10 SOHO</b> Won and ran second a head off a layoff in her first two turf sprints. Was stuck on the rail in the last two turf sprints in the lane and steadied and stopped in both (last out and 4 back). Makes second start off a break and gets Rispoli back up. Has 3 decent works for Sadler. Wide post will help here.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 9 ANG N ASH</b> This is the only runner in the race who has been up for a tag. She was claimed 5 back for 50k and has turned out to be a nice acquisition for this outfit. Toss last at the route when she lacked room in the lane. Just a neck from winning four straight before last. Will be running late in the race in here.</p> <p>A) 2,8,9,10 B) 1 C) 3,6 D) 4,7</p>	<p>6 – SANTA ANITA (5:35 ET) 56 MAIDEN CLAIMING 50K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>7 PRATCHETT 8-5 8 EAGLES DARE 4-1 6 LAST CALL PAUL 3-1 3 HERMELINDA'S FANCY 8-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 7 PRATCHETT</b> Despite having just two starts, he ran well in both. Was long odds in the debut back in February but beat 5 foes gamely when third. The winner came back to win an opt clm next out. Notice he was over 5 clear of third in last. The winner was 4-5 dropping from MSW to mdn clm. Is the one to beat.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 8 EAGLES DARE</b> While trainer Hess is 0 for 6 going MSW to maiden claiming in Cal-bred races on the dirt, he was second in all 6 of those starts. Debut vs. MSW in April is good enough to win. Eased in last but comes back quickly and attracts Rispoli. Guess is whatever happened there is rectified. Not facing a lot here.</p> <p>A) 7,8 B) 3,6 C) 1,5 D) 2,4</p>
<p>7 – SANTA ANITA (6:06 ET) 72 EDDIE LOGAN 100K, 1M TURF</p> <p>6 ARTISLAS 5-2 1 SABERTOOTH 4-1 2 KING OF DRAGONS 7-2 4 GAME WARRIOR 12-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 6 ARTISLAS</b> 3 for 4 for Jeff Mullins. The loss came last time out when he drew the 12 post out of 14 runners, had a wide trip and got into some traffic trouble in the big field. He did have some run late and was beaten just over 3-lengths. Major jockey change to Prat. Might be bit closer to the pace. Sharp drills.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 1 SABERTOOTH</b> Beat the top choice in the start two back when about half a length in front of him. Was just a hair behind him in two other starts previously. Deep closer was 2-5 in the maiden last out but kept lugging in through the lane and was just outfinished by Kings of Dragons (in here). A good trip wins.</p> <p>A) 1,6 B) 2 C) 3,4 D) 5,7</p>	<p>8 – SANTA ANITA (6:46 ET) 47 CLAIMING 20K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>2 STAY ON THE FENCE 5-2 4 DUTY FIRST 9-5 7 MEGA MOON 4-1 3 GOSTOSO 8-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 2 STAY ON THE FENCE</b> Lost the last race at the start when hammered by another foe and dropped far back early. He finished well for 2<sup>nd</sup> on a track that favored speed all day. Show finisher two back won an allowance at Los Al by 5 next. He figures to sit near the back and make a run up the rail. He's at the right level.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 3 GOSTOSO</b> The question here is if he can handle a track other than Los Alamitos. All of his best efforts have come there. He hasn't run all that well at SA. Winner of last won a 1000 yard hook allowance at Los Al next. Winner two back is the same one who beat the top choice in the last start. Fits at this 20k tag.</p> <p>A) 2,4,7 B) 1,3 C) 5,6,8 D)</p>	<p>9 – SANTA ANITA (7:18 ET) 56 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 60K, 6F TURF</p> <p>10 OM N JOY 10-1 4 WE THE HOBBY 7-2 9 SASAFRAN 5-1 3 GUILTYOFHAVINGFUN 4-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 10 OM N JOY</b> Sire Om was a superstar turf miler who was 2<sup>nd</sup> twice in the BC Turf Sprint ('16 and '19). His offspring are hitting at 24% in turf sprints. Poor starts in the first two races and again in the start two back. Winner of last won a 100k stakes in the next start. Dangerous if Pereira can navigate the wide post.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 WE THE HOBBY</b> Miller goes from an apprentice in the last two starts to one of the top riders in the world. Quite an upgrade when going to Flavian Prat here. Key race two back. All 5 who have run back hit the board from that race including 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> who both won MSW turf sprints at Del Mar.
