**PICK: 1 SHOWERS**  
 Bob Baffert is 20 for 44 (45%) with a MSW runner at Del Mar on the dirt at odds on. Winner of the debut shipped in from CD where she had been 2<sup>nd</sup> in 218K Debutante. G1 Belmont winners Jazil and Rags to Riches (and G1 Marathon winner, Man of Iron) are in the female family. Should love this added ground.

**VALUE: 3 TWO BAR**  
 Bob Baffert often runs one-two in races like this. If he has two in the race, and one is the big favorite as the rail runner is, his other charge often rounds out the exacta. The breeding here is more for route which is not the case with the other 3 horses here.

 He's 2 for 9 on the dirt. Routed in the last start and not surprisingly faded in the lane. Cuts back today and blinkers come off. Was a close 4<sup>th</sup> two back. Top three finishers from there all hit the board here at Del Mar next vs. higher class. Low percentage rider and trainer should ensure a good price in this one.

**VALUE: 4 ALEXIS S**  
 Ships in from GP where he was just second facing 12k company. Note the front wraps came off in the last start which was the first off the claim. Trainer does have a win at the meet. That was with another GP shipper earlier this month. Has some backclass.

Looking for a cleaner break in here.

**VALUE: 2 THE SCENT**  
 Not sure if this one can run. He's a 9k purchase in 2023. He did take some money in the 9-horse field in the last start and didn't get a very clean trip in there. Blinkers come on for the second career race today. Likely to get lost in the betting. Use in super.

If this race was run 10 times, this runner might hit the board once or twice. The odds dictate a look in a soft mdn clm 32k field. Trainer had a firster here in mdn clm this month run 3<sup>rd</sup> at 69-1. He also had a sib to this one run 2<sup>nd</sup> a neck here in debut in mdn clm 20k in 2016 at 17-1. Works on this one are better.

**VALUE: 3 JUST A LITTLE CYNN**

Faced MSW company in both starts but didn't beat a runner home in either. 8<sup>th</sup> in the debut beaten 23 came back to win a mdn clm 25k at Santa Rosa in the next start. This is a soft field so she should be an immediate player on the class drop. Early pace.

Was in the deep end of the water in the Real Good Deal last out. He was without Lasix and pressed the fast pace before tiring. The prior races were good enough to compete in here. The turf start 3 back is a key race. The top 5 all hit the board next time out.

**VALUE: 1 ANNA'S WISH**

Shipped in from New York and ended up the 3-1 fav in the common race many of these (including the top choice) come out of. She showed nothing with a middling 8<sup>th</sup> place finish. Was claimed by a high percentage outfit. Think we'll see much more here.

Very good effort in the first start here in So Cal for some time. He sat off the pace with Desormeaux aboard and close strongly to just miss. The winner of that race returned to take a 50k claimer here on the turf. Won on this turf when with Sadler in 2022.

That runner-up for Baffert returned to win 3 straight including G1 races at OP (Apple Blossom) and here earlier in Aug (CL Hirsch). Beat a G1 winner by 5 in last. It was 12 lengths back to 3<sup>rd</sup>. Looks a serious standout today.

**VALUE: 2 CHIMOSA**

She does have the distinction of being the only one to have beaten the top choice when she won a G3 at Santa Anita on New Year's Day. Was well behind the top pick in the last start but that was at LRC, a track many do not take to. She's 3 for 5 on this dirt.

The 2 best career efforts for this gelding came with Berrios up (back up today). Off pretty slow three back with Berrios but did surge to miss by a nose at 14-1 odds.

**VALUE: 10 CAPTAIN COOCHIES**

Basically eased last time out at 10-1. Decent 5<sup>th</sup> by 3 lengths the last time on the turf (3 back). He did actually win a race on turf in MSW at SA back in Jan but was DQ'd and placed third. Beaten a head only time on the Del Mar turf. Will be better in this spot.
