PICK: 1 SO FAR SO GOOD

Drew wide in the last start but sat a good trip when she got up for second at 5-1. Tries the same type of company here and goes back to Evin Roman who rode her twice before at IND and CD. Show finisher from the last start won in a 12k maiden claimer at OP on Friday. Saves ground and runs on.

VALUE: 3 HAND IT OVER

Career best effort came in the debut on this track at 46-1 in MSW company when she was really flying home to get up for third beaten just over a length. That 65 Beyer is one of the best in the field. Hasn't really been able to duplicate it since but did churn out 63, 68 Beyers. Sloppy track last out.

Third from there won a 16k claimer for fun at CD next. 9th beaten 24 ran 2nd by a neck for 14k claim at OP next. Might be tough up front.

Woodbine shipper has been primarily a router. Last time he was in a sprint was 4 back and he won that wire to wire at 5-2 odds. There is a fair amount of speed in this race but this one is likely going to travel midpack. Very tough race, many can win. Trainer 8 of 14 on the board at the TP meet.

VALUE: 10 TRIKITRAKI

This one is 2 for 4 on a synthetic surface and one of the two wins came here. That was in March of 2023. Been in with a lot of decent runners at Indiana. That track has produced a lot of winners around the country as their meet is loaded w/ good horses. Think he's better off the rail (had it last out).

PICK: 6 UNIVERSAL SOUND 300k purchase back a bit over two years ago. Has shown a fair amount of promise in 3 starts. Troubled trip at OP two back. Won in a key race in debut at 9-1. Third from there is now G1 placed. Beaten by a big closing 13-1 longshot in the last start. 1st, 3rd and 4th were all closers. Will improve today.	PICK: 1 COUNTER ELITE Came into the debut in a MSW at CD off a sharp set of drills back in late November. That was a strong race. 2 nd and 3 rd both ran back and finished 2 nd in stakes and MSW. Trainer is 0 for 41 in debut (just 8 in the money) so this one ran on his own. Figures to improve 2 nd out. Will be big odds today.	PICK: 5 DJANGO Unlike most trainers in this race, Kenneth McPeek is strong with runners going 9F or more. Toss the last start on a wet track. He hasn't handled that type of surface in his 3 starts over it. Key race two back. There were 5 next out winners from that race (winner stakes, the rest were in allowance).
VALUE: 4 KENTUCKY GO GO Was a neck behind Real Fast (#9 in here) in the last start at Indiana. He has a strong late kick which he showed off in 3 of his 5 starts. Always respect Doug O'Neill when he puts a lot of works into a horse off a freshening. Rider was aboard twice and just missing winning both at 22-1 and 5-1 in last.	VALUE: 12 COOL ANDY Trainer Peter Eurton used to be an auto-toss with firsters. But he's been better of late. This one is bred to sprint and brought home 500k in a sale 14 months ago. Eurton works them very slowly so you can't gauge these drills. He's been prepping a long time for this. Check the tote for more clues.	VALUE: 11 OSCARGOT He's already won at this 1M 1/4 distance when he won MSW here last out. He's been in some productive fields in his 5 starts so far. Trainer is having a good meet with 5 in the top 3 from 9 starts at the meet. Rider had options in this but he lands here. Bred to run all day. Might be an overlay in here.

PICK: 6 CALIFORNIA BURRITO Was bet down to 8-1 in the debut but did nothing. That run allowed the connections to drop him into high claimers in the second start and he destroyed that field. 2 nd came back to win by 9. Gave the winner in last a serious run (well clear of third). That winner was 2 nd in the Gun Runner last week.	PICK: 4 BABA VOSS His best races have been long distances and that isn't very surprising as the sire, Empire Maker, won the Belmont in 2003. Top two finishers two back won high level allowance races at SAR next (winner has since been second a neck in a G2). Sold in July for just 50k but remains protected here.	PICK: 9 DRAGON DREW 9YO gelding loves this track. He has won 7 of 24 starts over this synthetic surface with half of those 24 starts in the top two. Unlucky to lose last out when he pressed the pace and was getting to the winner (who drifted, a sign of lameness) in there. Major trouble two back as the fav. Gets a good trip.
VALUE: 1 TREW VIOLENCE Added blinkers on the stretchout in last and was sent off at 66-1. He did pass a few late to pick up 5 th money in a strong opt clm at CD. Top 4 from there were all coming in off wins in impressive fashion. Bred for distance. Draws the rail so expect the rider to hold the inside or drop back for one run.	VALUE: 3 TATANKA Hard to know if this 5YO gelding will be as effective for this new outfit after the claim two back. But we do know he will be well in front for most of this race. Races beyond 1M 1/16 often favor the controlling speed. Won his only start on the synthetic surface when he took an opt cl at GP 6 starts ago.	VALUE: 7 JW RUCKUS One of many out of the same race won by the likely favorite in here, Rivzonaroll. This one was lagging far behind. Only started running when the race was decided but did start moving late. Doesn't always show up but 9YO gelding can be a factor if the pace falls apart. Use under in the exotics.
