The thing about Mac Robertson is he will put his horses where they can win. This one crushed an overmatched Mn-bred maiden claimer and finds a fairly soft landing facing winners for the first time. Wide post and lack of speed in the race are concerns. Apprentice rider is back.

VALUE: 5 ALCAZABA

They took this one back off the pace from the rail in the last start. He has been able to close strongly in some of his past starts. But there is little early speed in this race so look for Quinonez to get him going out of the gate. He basically went wire to wire for first win 2 back at Tampa.

VALUE: 2 MACH TWO

After losing 3 photo finishes in his first 6 starts, he was able to break through with a dominant win 2 weeks ago. Sold for 36k in 2022 (decent price for a Mn-bred). Has shown quickness from the gate and the ability to stay in it after pressing the pace. Don't think we've seen his best.

VALUE: 4 JUPITER MISSION

Sire produced some excellent turfers like 2023 BC Turf Sprint winner Nobals and millionaire Vergara (was best a 1M 1/2 or longer). Willing to give him a look on a turf course that is firm (was yielding last out). Iowa-bred is likely here solely for the turf course. He will be an overlay.

Saves ground and swings out upper stretch.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 GYPSY REWARD She's been in the exacta in all 4 turf starts here at CBY. Came back in top form with a win from well off the pace here 5 weeks ago. It took her a bit longer to get into top form last year off the layoff. Often 5YO mares have their best season of racing. She beat open class 150k stakes company in the Dixie Belle two back. Interesting that Gallardo has been up 4 times and those account for her 4 wins. Absolutely destroyed Mn bred in her two starts here last year. Layoff only concern.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 NORTHERN ANGEL She's run well in all 3 starts. Came off the layoff to win 2 back at 7-1 and then was nosed out routing in the last start. Fuentes is off to the other Coty Rosin runner who will be more favored than this one. Run of the race.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 HALF BROTHER Never missed the board in 8 starts and actually in top 2 in 7 of 8. He's won 3 straight and crushed opt clm foes at EVD pretty easily at 33-1. Street Boss influence is all turf.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 CUPIDS CRUSH She looked like a serious Mn-bred after the upset in the Curtis Sampson Oaks vs. open class and a blowout win in the Frances Genter. Has underwhelmed in the starts since. Was lackluster in the Lady Slipper but it was her first start since Oct. Rider Harr been red-hot.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 FIRENSPICE Split the field in an open allowance at Fonner when off a year long break. Didn't have much of a chance at the higher opt clm level last out. She drew the 7 post at the 5F distance and then was off awkwardly before rushing up and fading. Drop helps her chances.
